The Sunday morning service at 10:00 will be led by Matt Meyer, an experienced lay liturgist. Matt's *Drumbeat for Darfur* program is a chance for people to participate in hands-on rhythm-making while learning about our commitments to Darfur. You will experience the spirituality of community music-making, as well as look at how rhythm and music intersect with Unitarian Universalist values. Bring your own drum if you wish!

In the afternoon from 1:00 to 2:00 pm, the First Parish Fogg Committee will sponsor a free *Drumbeat for Darfur* Fogg Lecture featuring Dr. Mohamed Ibrahim Elgadi, a Darfur refugee. Dr. Mohamed Elgadi is a survivor of torture in Sudan and is living in the United States under political asylum. Since coming to the US, he has worked to raise awareness about atrocities committed by the Sudanese government and the genocide in Darfur.
